WHEREAS, The Cabinet for Health and Family Services Department for Public Health's Radon Program, participating local health departments throughout the Commonwealth, Western Kentucky University, University of Kentucky and the United States Environmental Protection Agency recognize January 2012 as Radon Action Month in Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, Radon is a colorless, odorless, radioactive gas that may threaten the health of our citizens and their families and is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States;

WHEREAS, Testing for radon is simple and inexpensive and identified radon problems can be fixed; and

WHEREAS, The Cabinet for Health and Family Services Department for Public Health's Radon Program, participating local health departments throughout the Commonwealth and the United States Environmental Protection Agency support efforts encouraging Kentuckians to test their homes for radon, to reduce elevated levels of radon and to reveal the benefits of building radon resistant homes;
